WHO WE ARE

The American Indian Cancer Foundation (AICAF) is a national nonprofit organization that was established to address the tremendous cancer inequities faced by American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) people. At AICAF, we strive to eliminate cancer burdens in our communities through improved access to prevention, early detection, treatment and survivor support.

SCREEN OUR CIRCLE

Native women are disproportionately affected by both breast and cervical cancer. Across our communities:

- AI/AN women have a breast cancer death rate that is 10% higher than white women
- AI/AN women are twice as likely to develop cervical cancer compared to white women

Screen Our Circle is AICAF's National Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). It aims to increase cancer screening and early detection rates in urban AI/AN clinics across the nation, ultimately reducing the impacts of breast and cervical cancer in Indian Country. Screen Our Circle provides support to urban clinics and helps remove screening barriers by raising awareness of cancer burdens and solutions, promoting health system changes, and performing community education and outreach activities.
