

# COVID-19 Emergency Relief Funds for Cancer Survivors

Listed below are organizations actively accepting applications for financial assistance to cancer survivors. This list was last updated May 6, 2020.

# For All Cancer Survivors:

- Cancer Support Community Helpline Cancer Emergency Fund
  - **Description:** \$250 for essential, non-medical expenses
    - Eligibility: Patients in active treatment, including palliative and hospice care, meeting household income limits (\$36,420/individual; \$49,380/family of two; \$62,340/family of three; \$77,925/family of four or more)
  - **Contact:** 888-793-9355
- Family Reach COVID-19 Emergency Fund
  - **Description**: Undisclosed amount for essential, non-medical expenses
  - **Eligibility:** Patients in active treatment or within one year of treatment at any U.S. facility
  - **Contact:** 973-394-1411
- Healthwell Foundation COVID-19 Ancillary Costs Fund
  - **Description:** \$250 for food delivery, medication, COVID-19 testing, telehealth costs, transportation costs
  - Eligibility: Individuals and families with COVID-19 or with compromised immune systems (e.g., cancer survivors) and a COVID-19 exposure risk. Applicants must meet household income limits (\$63,800/individual; \$86,200/family of two; \$131,000 family of four)

#### For Blood Cancer Survivors

- Leukemia and Lymphoma Society COVID-19 Patient Financial Aid Program
  - **Description:** \$250 for essential, non-medical expenses
  - **Eligibility:** U.S. citizens and permanent residents, residing in the U.S., with a blood cancer diagnosis and that are actively being treated or in follow-up care
  - **Contact:** 877-557-2672

#### For Breast Cancer Survivors:

- The Pink Fund COVID-19 Real Help Now Fund
  - **Description:** Up to \$3,000 for cost-of-living bills
  - Eligibility: Patients undergoing active treatment of breast cancer who can prove a loss of working income

# For Colorectal Cancer Survivors:

- <u>Colorectal Cancer Alliance COVID-19 Crisis Financial Assistance Fund</u>
  - **Description:** \$200 for essential, non-medical expenses
  - Eligibility: Colorectal cancer patients in treatment
  - **Contact: 877-422-2030**

# For Lung Cancer Survivors:

- Breathe Easier: An Emergency Response Fund for Lung Cancer Patients During COVID-19 Crisis
  - **Description:** \$500 for essential, non-medical expenses
  - Eligibility: US citizens and permanent residents receiving care for lung cancer in the United States with a household income limit of 300% of the federal poverty limit (\$38,280/individual; \$51,720/family of two; \$78,600/family of four).

# For Survivors of Rare Cancers:

- <u>National Association of Rare Disorders (NORD) COVID Critical Relief Fund</u>
  - **Description:** Up to \$1,000 for essential, non-medical expenses
  - Eligibility: Individuals and immediate family members of an individual with a confirmed rare cancer diagnosis. Must be a United States citizen or permanent resident with a household income that is at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Level guidelines or that may demonstrate a financial impact due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
